They required an infrastructure provider capable of:

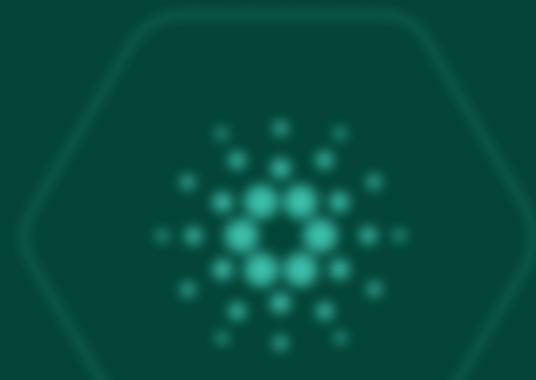
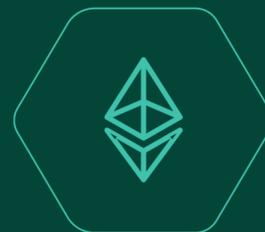
